## HEART Fund Supports Team Members in Crisis

During the holidays, we often think of helping those in need. The Front Porch Communities Foundation’s HEART Fund was set up to help Front Porch team members who face a crisis. The HEART (Helping Employees At Risk Today) Fund has provided financial support to more than 275 of our team members who have faced an unexpected financial crisis. Help has ranged from critical medical care for a child to home repairs after a natural disaster, car repairs from an uninsured motorist crash to funeral costs for a parent.

Front Porch community residents and family members support the HEART Fund, but the majority of the funds are donated by Front Porch staff members. Donna Guardado, senior executive assistant at Claremont Manor, is a generous donor to the HEART Fund. “I give to this fund because I feel in my heart that if there is a way to help someone in need, I want to give what I can to hopefully make a difference,” she said. “A person never knows when they may need help, maybe even me one day, so even if I can’t give much, I know that every little bit helps.”
